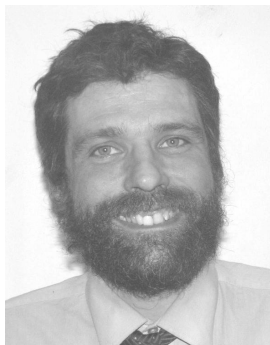

A better environment

Are you alarmed by this government's indifference to the horrendous future consequences of climate change? We will work to scrap all Weapons of Mass Destruction, including our own, and halt the manufacture and export of arms. Greens will protect those fleeing persecution and work for a just asylum system. We fight to end all forms of racism, sexism, homophobia, and discrimination on grounds of disability or religion. We will give pensioners a fair deal.
