our 7 point plan for Dudden Hill and Brent

1. Campaign to end unsafe air pollution from Neasden Goods Yard and the North Circular Road.
2. Work closely with Dollis Hill House Trust to restore the House for community use.
3. Campaign against privatisation of our schools and promote youth clubs.
4. Defend the NHS and end cost-shunting of medical care onto Council taxpayers.
5. Fund decent public transport, cycling lanes and pavement repair.
6. End Brent arms investment and the transport of nuclear waste through the borough.
7. Make solar panels compulsory on all new buildings.

Your Candidate

BRENT GREENS have selected **SHARRAR ALI** as their by-election candidate. Born in Suffolk, he has lived and worked in London most of his life. Dr Ali has a PhD in philosophy, has taught for the WEA and is Green Party Policy Coordinator for London. Sharrar moved to Brent in 2000, after working in the European Parliament on environmental risk regulation.

Sharrar has campaigned with Brent Greens alongside residents on problems as diverse as neighbourhood policing, bus prioritisation and phone masts; to exposing nuclear waste trains, promoting recycling and saving our local heritage.

Sharrar stood for Brent East in 2005 (905 Green votes) and the GLA in 2004 (6,975 Green). Across London, we now have two Assembly Members, one MEP and 12 councillors. Help us to elect our first Green to Brent Council - in order to help you!

Sharrar says: *“Green politics is about pursuing radical solutions that other politicians claim are impossible. Green politics is about active listening, joined-up thinking, then taking a lead. Green politics is about overcoming cynicism to make our vision real for the sake of our children’s children and other species we share the planet with.”*

“I will insist upon critical, but mature, dialogue with opposition politicians for the greater good of Brent residents. Just think what a difference a strong Green voice will make in the Council and for our campaigns!”
